

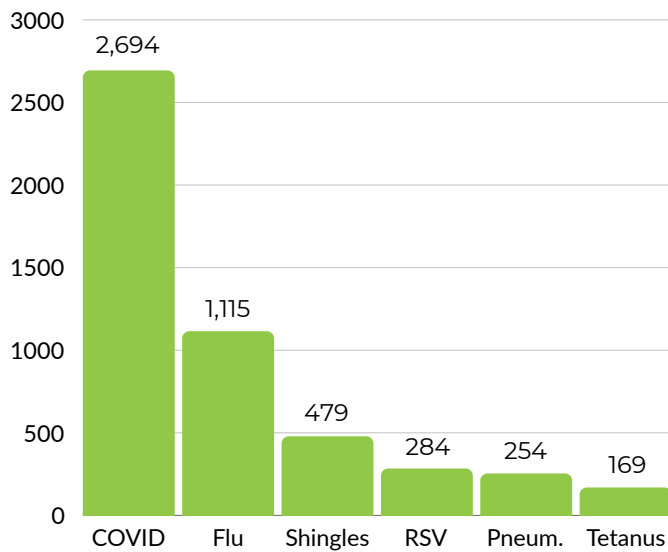


2024 HEALTH CLINIC OUTCOMES



The WEEE Care mobile vaccination clinic initiative has made a profound impact on the communities it serves, showcasing the power of **targeted, community-centered healthcare delivery** and strong cross-sector partnerships.

Shots Administered by Category:



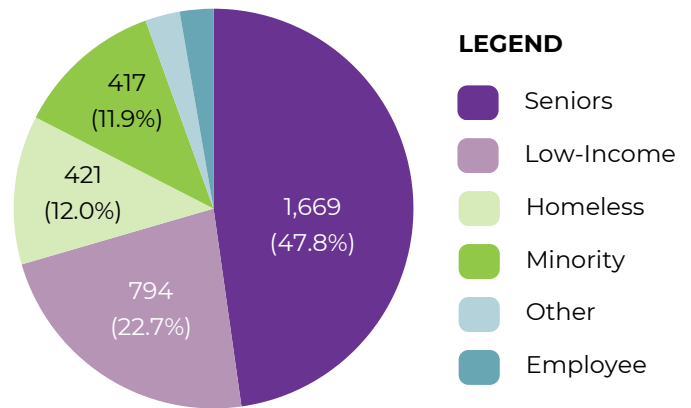
WEEE Care proudly covered the cost of 82 shots for **67 uninsured individuals**, an investment of \$6,135.00. In addition to vaccines, our clinics offer a variety of complementary services to promote overall health and wellness with the support of our partners. These included educational sessions on vaccine safety and efficacy, consultations on preventive health practices, and referrals to other healthcare resources.

Marketing and Outreach:



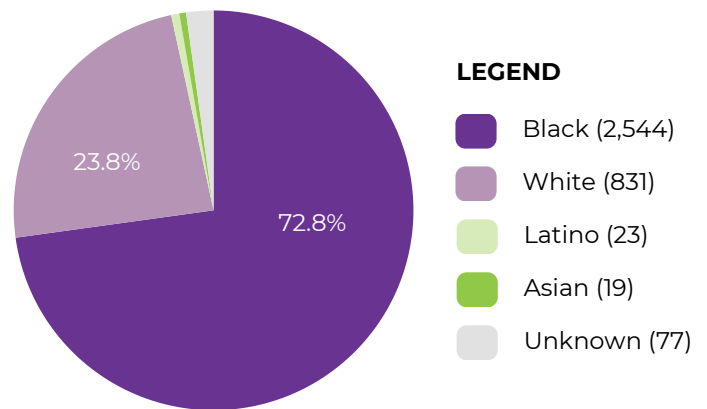
To encourage participation and reduce barriers to access, incentives such as grocery gift cards and cash were provided to clinic participants. These efforts were instrumental in increasing community engagement and trust.

Participants by Target Population:



We focus on the places where marginalized people live and gather to reach seniors residing in congregate housing, residents of public and subsidized housing, faith-based communities, and individuals experiencing homelessness.

Participant Racial Demographics:



Consistent with our goal to reach marginalized people in our region, the majority of individuals served were Black (72.8%). Most of our white participants also belonged to at-risk groups as senior, low-income, or unhoused individuals.
